

## **DOES THE ENTRAN HEATING SYSTEM LAWSUIT AFFECT YOU?**

The Telluride Association of Realtors is providing a public service announcement for all regional homeowners whose property was built in between 1988 and 1996 and has radiant in-floor heat via the Heatway Entran II Radiant Heating Hose. There have been significant failures of this product and every owner of property containing heating Entran II hose is at risk of significant damage. In 2004 a Federal Court approved a settlement between Goodyear and Entran II owners and the settlement over time will be worth over \$200 million. This money is the only money that will be available to owners for any subsequent damages.

A service appointment with a local heating and plumbing technician and brief analysis will determine if you have Entran II tubing. The deadline to file a claim is November 19, 2009 and after this date if you have this product and it fails you will not be compensated, as Heatway went out of business, and Goodyear, who manufactured the hose, agreed to fund this settlement only.
